What is SET?

The Support for Education & Training (SET) Programme is designed to provide recent graduates of recognized universities and the St. Vincent & the Grenadines Community College with relevant work experience within the public sector and affiliated agencies. This is a temporary work assignment and successful applicants cannot apply for extension or renewal of contract. The interns will perform whatever duties are assigned to them and are subject to all terms and conditions set out in their contracts.

Employers are demanding graduates with work-place ready skills. They want employees with job skills such as communication, teamwork and problem-solving capabilities. They require that new employees be ready to learn and work.

The Government has realized that it can play a vital role in developing the workforce of the future by being part of the education experience. These types of opportunities for young people can have a real impact on graduate employability and workplace readiness.



Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons who wish to be considered for internships under the Support for Education and Training (SET) Programme.

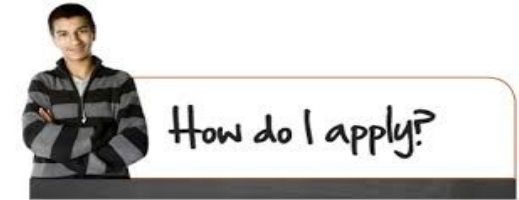
Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be the holder of at least a Bachelor's degree from a recognized and accredited university ;
or
- Be a graduate of the St. Vincent and the Grenadines Community College who has successfully completed the requirements for an Associate Degree, or possess a minimum of two (2) double-unit CAPE and/ or GCE Advanced level subjects, as well as Communication Studies.
- Graduates of the Division of Nursing Education must have successfully completed the Regional Nursing Examinations and must be registered and licensed to practise in St. Vincent & the Grenadines.
- **ALL** academic qualifications **MUST** be certified by the National Accreditation Unit, Ministry of Education.
- Have limited work experience
- Be between the ages of 18 to 35 yrs

Successful applicants will be engaged for a period of one (1) year on a contractual basis.

Remuneration

- University graduates will be paid at a rate of \$2,200 per month
- College graduates will be paid at a rate of \$1,000 per month
